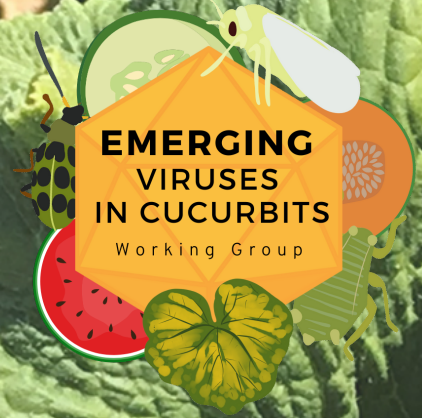


## Webinar Series

# Cucurbit Viruses in the United States



This **FREE** webinar series will discuss each of the key viruses known to impact or infect cucurbits in the United States. Each webinar will focus on one or more groups of viruses. An introductory presentation in the first webinar will introduce attendees to the EVCWG and the overall cucurbit virus situation in the U.S. All subsequent presentations will be approximately 10 minutes in length and focus on a single virus or related viruses and discuss the initial appearance or identification in the U.S., the cucurbit hosts affected, and the mode(s) of transmission; the geographic incidence in the U.S.; virus symptoms expressed on key cucurbit hosts and disease development; methods required for diagnosis; details on virus spread and transmission; epidemiologically important factors for virus spread (e.g., host range, vector prevalence, weather, occurrence in mixed infections); and methods for virus and virus disease management. Webinars will end with a short Q&A session.
